22nd Sunday in Ordinary ☩ Time ☐ Luke 14:1, 7-14

Luke uses one of Jesus' favorite teaching modes in the Gospel for this Sunday – the parable. The parable is an interesting form of literature in that it is never meant to be taken literally. A parable uses one situation to examine a second. The gospel for this week deals with humility. The setting and story about a meal are meant to help us consider the heavenly banquet to which we are all called. The invitation comes regardless of our station in life and is not based on merit. God's generosity makes scrambling for position at the banquet senseless and fruitless. Once we have realized how undeserving we are of the invitation, the more exalted we are in accepting the invitation. This is the humility to which we are called. **What does it mean for you to be "humble before God?" What opportunities are available in your community to care for the least (seemingly) in the Kingdom of God? How can we best respond to the cry of the poor and make it an example of accepting the invitation to the banquet?**
