## **FREE DAILY PRAYER BOOKS**

A FREE book of prayer for lay people is available to take home in the vestibules, while they last. The book, *Give Us This Day*, has excerpts from the Liturgy of the Hours, Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer, a short biography of the saint of the day, and the scriptures used in the mass of the day, for each day of the month of August.

There are cards bound into the back of the books so that you can subscribe, if you wish. But feel free to take a copy and "try it out." The Liturgy of the Hours is meant to be prayed by everyone in the Church. It's a way to make the whole day "holy" by punctuating it with prayer that is shared throughout the Church.

The Second Vatican Council decided that it should be made more accessible to the people, and not something that is just "said" by priests and religious, but a prayer to be shared by all the members of the Church. It's not your grandfather's *Breviary* any more!
