✠Third Sunday in Ordinary Time ✠ Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21

In today's gospel passage from Luke, we learn that Jesus returned to Galilee (where he had grown up) and in the power of the Holy Spirit, began to teach in the Synagogues, and was praised by all. When he came to Nazareth, he went into the Synagogue and read from the scroll (or book) of the prophet Isaiah: "***The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, and to let the oppressed go free. "What are the "glad tidings" that Jesus brings to you? How can you share them with others?***"
