Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

Jesus wants the whole world to know that the Kingdom of God is at hand. So, he sends his disciples out to gather the harvest (harvest means people who have not heard the Good News of the Gospel). He tells the disciples they must go quickly and travel light. ***How many disciples did Jesus have at that time? (seventy two). How many disciples do you think we have today? (probably millions). As a disciple of Jesus, what are you doing to let people know about Jesus' love and the Kingdom of God?***

St. Therese Trivia

Father Schmitz continued as pastor throughout the 1960s as the number of parishioners climbed to nearly 800 families.

His assistants in this period were Father John Keane, Father W.A. Forbes, Father W.R. Vaughters, Father Ronald Warren, and Father Gerald McCray. School principals were Sister Emilia Techtman, O.P., 1958-1961; Sister Florita Seidle, O.P., 1961-1962; Sister Eucharica Hecht, O.P., 1962-1964; and Sister Florence Cumbelich, O.P., 1964-1970.

The first church, now the Multi Purpose Center, was dedicated on January 12, 1964. The school became a full eight grade system in 1960, and the first graduation was held May 31, 1961. Enrollment in the school exceeded 200.

Deliberations of the Second Vatican Council in the early years of this decade were reflected in the parish: use of the vernacular in the rites; changes in the sanctuary, and the election of the first Parish Council in the spring of 1967. The first Men's Choir sang initially at the Midnight Mass of Christmas 1960.
